

Publication Checklist for prospective authors aspiring to publish in the Journal 'ENGINEER'

| Steps | Procedure | Alternatives |

| 1. | Go to IESL web-site www.iesl.lk and follow the link to Journal web-page - ENGINEER. Thoroughly peruse and familiarize with the content available (including web-links) for information on Scope, Level, Content, Editorial policies, Copyright conditions, Indexing, Archiving, etc. | |
| 2. | Ascertain whether at least one of the authors of the prospective paper has a membership in any one of the categories in IESL. | If you have a high impact finding related to engineering to report, you may submit a paper, though none of the authors have membership at IESL. It may be accepted for processing if the Editor and the Editorial Board are satisfied of its impact. |
| 3. | Download following documents on publication in ENGINEER namely; Overview on Publication ... (iesl/journal/overview), Offer to Submit ... (iesl/journal/offer) and Format & Layout ... (iesl/journal/format), from the website (www.iesl.lk) and compile the paper strictly adhering to the formats and guidelines therein. | |
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| 6. | Publication Division will inform whether the paper has been preliminarily accepted for review/ modifications are needed/ or not accepted. | |
| 7. | During review process cycles, Referees comments/suggestions/ modifications will be informed to the corresponding author from time-to-time for action. | Corresponding author may query the progress of the review process from Manager Publications (dir.pub@iesl.lk) or Staff Assistant, Publications (SA[P]) ieslpub@gmail.com . |
| 8. | Corresponding Author will be informed of the final acceptance/rejection of the paper. | |
