








Figure 04: Event #01




Figure 17: Feedback from participants




Figure 27: Feedback from participants






Figure 30: Event #14




Figure 31: Feedback from participants




Figure 32: Event #15






Figure 35: Guests and Committee Member of VDC




Figure 36: Participated Members via Zoom
