This new guide line is preparing by tri-languages in a same document and it fulfills the government policy as well.

It is proposed to introduce an online application form for the school students for applying for the competition. This would be more timely with the prevailing situation of the country. Fliers and awareness videos are being prepared prior to the official launching of both JIY and UIY competitions for year 2021. Organizers are working for exposing real industrial related problems for investors and get the industrial assistance for their inventions and innovation.

Meanwhile it is proposed to appoint JIY representators for each Districts and Major Schools. Those representators will coordinate the application forms and guiding invention clubs of the Schools for better developments.
