ELECTIONS TO THE COUNCIL FOR SESSION 2019/2020 E Voting INSTRUCTIONS TO THE VOTERS

Following instructions will help you to successfully cast your votes through E-voting option. Please go through the procedure outlined below prior to casting your vote.

 Eligible voters will have the option of selecting, e-voting, or paper voting or both. If any voter casts his/her vote by using both the paper voting and electronic voting options, only the paper vote will be counted, and the <u>electronic vote will be</u> <u>disregarded</u>.

2. E-Voting procedure:

- a. The voting portal will be open from the day of commencement of the voting (at 8.30 am (Sri Lanka time) on 01st August 2019) until closing time and date for voting (at 2.00 pm (Sri Lanka time) on 29th August 2019).
- b. The URL (<u>https://au.civiciti.com/ww/iesl</u>) for the electronic voting portal along with the User ID (Voter ID) will be sent to eligible voters by the E-voting Service Provider via the email registered in the IESL database.
- c. Voter can login to the voting portal using the URL received through the email. Voter is advised to first read the election statement and bio-data of each candidate to be voted (optional).
- d. Eligible voter may then select the option for receiving the Voting Code/One Time Password (OTP), via SMS or Email by entering the User ID (Voter ID) and Email Address/Mobile number.
- e. Service provider will match the credentials entered and then send the **Voting Code (OTP)** to registered mobile number or email (based on the preference in step (d)) of the voter.
- f. This will provide access to the electronic ballot paper in the usual manner. OTP is valid only for One (01) hour.
- g. Electronic Ballot paper is visible only for 10 minutes. If you could not fill it and submit within 10 minutes (session-out time), you should request for a fresh OTP by starting from item (d) above.

IMPORTANT:

Validity of credentials you enter

Make sure that credentials including your Email/Mobile no/User ID (Voter ID)

/Voting Code (OTP) etc should comply with following.

- should not have any spaces
- verified upper/lower case letters

- mobile number should not have country code. Country should be separately selected (by clicking the flag).

- Receiving User/Voter ID via Email
 - If you do not receive this email into your usual 'Inbox', please check spam folder, Promotions folder, Social folder etc.

Take advantage of the double option (Email and Mobile)

If for some reason the first option does not work, try the other option to receive your Voting Code (OTP).

Required instructions are provided in the voting portal as a Video Clip, to assist the voter. Once the vote is cast using the User/Voter ID and Voting Code (OTP) sent to him/her, no one will be able to cast a vote using the same User/Voter ID and Voting Code (OTP).

Closing time of the Ballot: Both e-voting and paper voting will be closed at <u>2.00 pm</u> (Sri Lanka time) on Thursday - 29th August 2019.

4. If a voter, attempting the e-voting option cannot successfully Login at the first instance, he/she can make multiple attempts. If there is any recurring problem, he/she could seek the assistance of one of the Election Officials listed below who would respond on priority basis. Once successfully voted, a confirmation message will appear on the screen. All voters are advised to use their vote very early.
