

THE INSTITUTION OF ENGINEERS, SRI LANKA**GUIDELINES FOR REGISTRATION AS AN ARBITRATOR/ADJUDICATOR FOR LISTING
IN THE DIRECTORY OF ARBITRATORS/ADJUDICATORS MAINTAINED BY THE IESL****1. Registration as an Arbitrator**

Any Corporate Member who wishes to register himself/herself as an Arbitrator is required to satisfy the requirements set out below. He/she should,

- a) be a Corporate Member of the Institution
- b) have more than 10 years' experience after becoming a Corporate Member

Evaluation criteria to be registered as an Arbitrator are as follows;

- Educational & Professional Qualifications Minimum 10 years after the charter (15 marks out of 100)
- Project Management Experience (10 marks out of 100)
- Experience in Arbitration process (15 marks out of 100)
- Courses followed in Arbitration (15 marks out of 100)
- Knowledge (Conditions of Contract) FIDIC/CIDA (25 marks out of 100)
- Communication Skills & Report Writing Skills (20 marks out of 100)

2. Registration as an Adjudicator

Any Corporate Member who wishes to register himself/herself as an Adjudicator is required to satisfy the requirements set out below. He/she should,

- a) be a Corporate Member of the Institution
- b) have more than 3 years' experience after becoming a Corporate Member

Evaluation criteria to be registered as an Adjudicator are as follows;

- Educational & Professional Qualifications – Minimum 3 years after obtaining the Corporate Membership of the IESL (15 marks out of 100)
- Project management Experience (10 out of 100 marks)
- Experience in Adjudication process (15 marks out of 100)
- Courses followed in Adjudication (15 marks out of 100)
- Knowledge (Conditions of Contract) FIDIC/CIDA (25 marks out of 100)
- Communication Skills & Report Writing Skills (20 marks out of 100)

Those who possess the required qualifications and experience have to be successful at an interview, by obtaining over 75 marks for each category, conducted by a Panel of Senior Engineers having experience in arbitration/adjudication, appointed by the Institution.
