## GUIDELINES FOR REGISTRATION AS AN ARBITRATOR/ADJUDICATOR FOR LISTING IN THE DIRECTORY OF ARBITRATORS/ADJUDICATORS MAINTAINED BY THE IESL

## 1. Registration as an Arbitrator

Any Corporate Member who wishes to register himself/herself as an Arbitrator is required to satisfy the requirements set out below. He/she should,

- 1. be a Corporate Member of the Institution
- 2. Has to have more than 10 years' experience after becoming a Corporate Member

Evaluation criteria to be registered as an Adjudicator are as follows;

- Educational & Professional Qualifications Minimum 10 years after the charter (25 marks out of 100)
- Experience in Engineering (10 Marks out of 100)
- Experience in Arbitrator process (15 marks out of 100)
- Courses followed in Arbitration (10 marks out of 100)
- Knowledge (Conditions of Contract) FIDIC/CIDA (25 marks out of 100)
- Communication Skills & Report Writing Skills (15 marks out of 100)

## 2. Registration as an Adjudicator

Any Corporate Member who wishes to register himself/herself as an Adjudicator is required to satisfy the requirements set out below. He/she should,

- 1. be a Corporate Member of the Institution
- 2. have more than 3 years' experience after becoming a Corporate Member
- 3. have more than 10 years' post qualifying experience after obtaining recognize academic qualifications.

Evaluation criteria to be registered as an Adjudicator are as follows;

- Educational & Professional Qualifications Minimum 3 years after obtaining the Corporate Membership of the IESL (25 marks out of 100)
- Experience in Engineering (10 Marks out of 100)
- Experience in Adjudication process (15 marks out of 100)
- Courses followed in Adjudication (10 marks out of 100)
- Knowledge (Conditions of Contract) FIDIC/CIDA (25 marks out of 100)
- Communication Skills & Report Writing Skills (15 marks out of 100)

Those who possess the required qualifications and experience have to be successful at an interview conducted by a Panel of Senior Engineers having experience in arbitration/adjudication, appointed by the Institution.
